For these very curious tables, we are indebted to an army contractor, a gentleman of great observation and singular accuracy. They furnish documents of much interest as to the comparative height and breadth of men in different counties in Scotland, from which inferences may be drawn as to the influence of the nature of the county and climate, food, and occupation, upon the growth of man. Before, however, any general conclusions can be safely adopted, more facts of the same kind must be accumulated.
